Group Qualifications

CanSkate participants are in Levels 1-4 of the CanSkate program

Junior Academy participants are in either CanSkate levels 5-7 or in introduction to StarSkate.

Primary or Junior participants are working on singles, are pre-preliminary or elementary qualified and are first year CanSkate competitive.

Intermediate B participants are landing all singles, working on axels and are preliminary qualified (not passed prelim free).

Intermediate A participants are landing axels and have passed Prelim freeski.

Senior participants are Senior Bronze-to Gold and Juvenile up.
