This weekend is our most fun competition of the year. From Rising Star to Star 4, skaters will show off in front of their friends and family at this local event.


While we have so many people at the rink, we are going to have our sea can open. We are asking for parents to come out to the parking lot while they are waiting and lend a hand while we:



 - Works with bookkeeper to ensure finances are inline
 - Submits annual gaming and grant applications, applies for gaming license (50/50)
 - Signing authority for cheques
- Director (3)

The terms are for 2-years. As a board, we meet once a month, taking breaks for the winter and summer holidays. Calls for nomination will go in at the beginning of May.
