Dear Parents and Skaters,

Ice Show picture days are scheduled for next Monday and Tuesday. Please review the [skater groupings](#) and [schedule](#) and make sure that your skater is in attendance no later than the time dedicated listed to report to the designated change room.

**Costumes:** The costumes have been made and will be assigned to the skaters at the picture day. Please attend with your child/children dressed in form fitting clothes (tights and t-shirt) (light coloured for Star Academy) that the costume can be put over top. Also please bring the helmet (NO CAGE) and skates. The children will NOT be skating on ice.

**\*\*Please note that the Star Academy group have 2 numbers with 2 photo sessions. Please be prepared to be present from 6:00- 8:30 pm on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 if your skater is part of this group.\*\***

If possible, please leave siblings who are not having their picture taken at home. The change rooms are small and crowd quickly. A parent must stay with child during picture event.

**\*\*ALL Skaters under 12\*\***

**Skater information forms:** It is required that **all skaters under 12** years of age have a completed form with a **photo attached** prior to receiving a costume for their pictures March 2nd or 3<sup>rd</sup>. The form is attached to this email and posted on the website. Hard copies are also posted to our bulletin boards at the MacLaren arena. This form is for your child's safety during dress rehearsal and show night when they are monitored and managed back stage by parent volunteers.

Other dates to remember:

- **March 30- April 8<sup>th</sup> 2020** - practice
  - there will be two practices on separate nights in the week and a half before the show. The dates and times will be determined shortly and sent out in an email. Practices will be held at the Okanagan Hockey School and Training Center ice (853 Eckhardt Ave West). They will need their helmet and skates and will be on ice for practices. Your skater must attend these practices in order to participate.
- **April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020** – dress rehearsal
  - skaters will need to be at the South Okanagan Events Center (853 Eckhardt Ave West) from approximately 5:30 – 7:15 pm. A parent/guardian needs to remain at the arena and are encouraged to watch the dress rehearsal if they wish. Skaters will need their helmet and skates and will be on ice. Parents are NOT allowed back stage to be with their child UNLESS they are part of the volunteer backstage team. If you are anxious about your child's ability to be left with a group of children without your assistance, please be sure to sign up as a volunteer.
