



Dear Star Skate Parents,

You are receiving this letter because your child is registered in the Star Skate program at Glengarry. Every year Glengarry holds an Ice Show. The purpose of the Ice Show is to allow skaters to showcase their skills and share their love of skating with their community.

Primary (Star 1-3)

This year the ice show will be The Lion King. The primary skaters will be in two numbers (giraffes and parrots).

There are some **mandatory dates** to keep in mind:

- **January 31, 2019** – sign up deadline to participate sign up at [Ice Show sign up](#). There is a \$40 fee for primary skaters to participate.
- **March 7, 2019** - 6:15 pm picture night
 - your skater will need to come to McLaren Arena by 6:15 to register and be given their costume. They will need beige tights and an undershirt that they will be comfortable wearing underneath their costume (long sleeve shirts). They will need to stay for group and individual pictures. They will need their skates (but won't be going on the ice)
- **April 1-9th 2019** - practice
 - there will be five practices on separate nights in the week and a half before the show. The dates and times will be determined shortly and sent out in an email. Practices will be held at the Okanagan Hockey School and Training Center ice (853 Eckhardt Ave West). They will need their skates and will be on ice for practices.
- **April 10th, 2019** – dress rehearsal
 - skaters will need to be at the South Okanagan Events Center (853 Eckhardt Ave West) from approximately 5:30 – 7:15 pm. A parent/guardian needs to remain at the arena and is able to watch the dress rehearsal if they wish. Skaters will need their tights, undershirt, and skates and will be on ice.
- **April 11, 2019**- show night
 - skaters will need to be there at 5:45 and can be picked up after the show. A parent/guardian needs to remain at the arena. Skaters will need their tights and undershirt, and skates and will be on ice.

Intermediate and Senior (Star4-Competitive)

This year, these skaters will be taking the main roles in the show. Costumes will be provided. There is a \$60 charge to sign up.

Mandatory dates:

January 31st- deadline to register

March 7th- 7:00 picture night and costumes McLaren Arena
